## **Picos Prophecy**


On 7 August 2010 13:45, Rob Garrett wrote:



So I was looking back through some past expedition reports and I was reminded of something I'd noted at the time. The 'Holier Than Thou' inlet in 2/7 ends at a rising sump directly below Tras La Jayada. Checking the 1999 report, confirms that HTT inlet was notable for an extremely cold draught, "in particular, around 50m back from the sump there is a climb up through boulders that appears to take most of the strong draught that makes the whole of Holier Than Thou so cold."




The shaft is quite dangerous thanks to the falling lumps of ice.


